School Strike 4 Climate - Thousands of New Zealand school students plan to go “on strike” on March 15 to support a worldwide day of action over global warming.

The global strike is expected to bring tens of thousands of students on to the streets across Europe, the United States, Australia and other countries.

In Wellington, students will assemble at Civic Square at 10am on March 15 and march to Parliament, where youth representatives will speak and then put questions to a cross-party panel of MPs.

Join us at Civic Square at 10am on Friday 15th March to walk to Parliament down Lambton Quay to demand urgent action on climate change. We are taking control of the conversation around our future.

There will be speakers, activities and chanting! Let's show the world we won't stand for no more inaction on the environment. We demand that the New Zealand Government do more now to hold global warming to no more than 1.5 degrees Celsius.

We encourage you to bring food for a picnic lunch on Parliament grounds during the strike.
