Board of Trustees Elections Reminder – Voting papers can be posted or dropped off at the school office

The New Zealand School Trustees Association has advised that NZ Post can no longer guarantee that all envelopes will be post marked before delivery. For those envelopes containing voting papers that are not post marked, returning officers will not have any evidence that the envelope has been posted before noon on election day.

Because of this change by NZ Post, all voting papers, including postal votes, will now need to be received by our returning officer CES by noon on Friday 7 June 2019 to be counted as valid. Please post your votes as soon as possible to ensure that you meet this deadline.

Please note that voting papers can also be dropped off at the school office before midday on Friday 07 June.

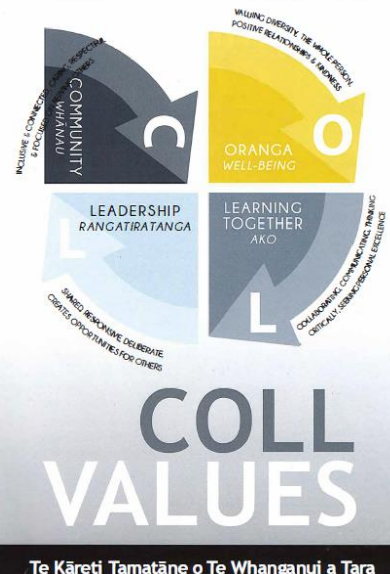
