From the Principal

Kia ora tātou

As outlined in the emailed updates sent already, we have had a settled start to the school year. Children have taken the introduction of masks in their stride and they are showing real independence as they manage themselves at the start of the day, particularly our younger students. A huge thank you for your support and trust and a thank you to our staff for the welcoming, flexible way they are approaching the challenges of working within the Red setting of the COVID Protection Framework (CPF).

You will be aware from the media that some schools have already had COVID cases amongst their students and staff. If we are notified of a case of COVID at KNS, we would work closely with the Ministry of Education and Ministry of Health to identify those children and staff who were close contacts. We would also notify the school community that there was a confirmed case of COVID, as quickly as we can.

- If your child is identified as being a close contact you would be informed of this, via email, and receive information about the steps you should take. The current process for close contacts is that they need to get tested and then self-isolate for 10 days from the date they had contact with the case.
- If your child is not a close contact, you will receive a message, via email, that will be sent to the rest of the school community informing them that were not identified as close contacts.

Our aim is to keep the school open for all children, except, those who are unwell or identified as close contacts.

Keeping the school open may pose some challenges for us and it is likely to look and feel slightly different. We will probably have a number of our teaching staff sick and/or self-isolating, as well as students. We will do our best to keep learning programmes going for both the children at school and those at home. Our current plan for those children who are selfisolating, is that we will provide work for these students and it will be monitored by part-time teachers, rather than classroom teachers, who will be keeping our face-to-face onsite programmes going. There may come a point where the lack of availability of staff means that we would move to online learning for all children, except those of essential workers.

Please note this is our current planning and this might change very quickly given that there are so many unknowns e.g. the numbers of children and staff self-isolating and the availability of staff. We will keep you updated regularly and I ask that you be understanding if this does not work perfectly all the time.
