#### Hero – School App

This week we launched our new school app – Hero. Our investment in this app was a direct result of your feedback to our Communications Survey last year where you told us that you wanted a solution that would bring all our school information together in one place. Hero provides a safe and secure platform for us to share important information with you.

It will also help us change how we communicate with you. Newsletters, team updates and communication, permission slips, surveys, recording absences, lists of key dates and links to Kindo and in time other systems will all be available from the Hero app. This means that email will be kept for emergency communication, reducing the volume of emails we send.

You will have received instructions on how to access and download the app and we have QR code flyers around the school for you as well. To start with, the app will support and link you to the main day-to-day communications you may need, and we're looking forward to adding to this over time. I'm confident the app will help us streamline our communication with you and I encourage you to download it as soon as you can.

#### COVID Updates

As outlined in last week's newsletter, please email me if you wish to receive daily updates on the number of positive COVID cases at school. The reasons I decided not to send daily updates to all parents/caregivers were; not wanting to; 'bombard' people's inboxes and raise community anxiety levels.

Please find below information regarding the number of positive cases at KNS as of today:

- This week are starting to see children returning to school, as they are at Day 11 of their self-isolation and have no COVID symptoms, five children are in this category.
- In total we have 26 positive cases throughout the school distributed as follows:
  - Year 0 0 cases
  - Year 1 0 cases
  - Year 2 1 case
  - Year 3 7 cases
  - Year 4 0 cases
  - Year 5 6 cases
  - Year 6 3 cases
  - Year 7 8 cases
  - Year 8 1 case
