I am currently isolating at home because I am a household contact. This week has reinforced how fortunate I am to work with a group of people who show initiative and 'go the extra mile'. I am managing to get most tasks done remotely and I'm extremely grateful for the support and hard work of those onsite, as they keep things operating as normally as possible at KNS.

Hero – School App Reminder

Last week we launched our new school app – Hero. Our investment in this app was a direct result of your feedback to our Communications Survey last year where you told us that you wanted a solution that would bring all our school information together in one place. Hero provides a safe and secure platform for us to share important information with you.

It will also help us change how we communicate with you. Newsletters, team updates and communication, permission slips, surveys, recording absences, lists of key dates and links to Kindo and in time other systems will all be available from the Hero app. This means that email will be kept for emergency communication, reducing the volume of emails we send.

You will have received instructions on how to access and download the app and we have QR code flyers around the school for you as well. Resources to further support you access the app are available on our website<u>here</u> and Jaqueline can help you with extra queries, just email her on <u>office@kns.school.nz</u>.

To start with, the app will support and link you to the main day-to-day communications you may need, and we're looking forward to adding to this over time. I'm confident the app will help us streamline our communication with you and I encourage you to download it as soon as you can.

We want to move as quickly as we can to Hero so we aren't duplicating our communications. However we understand that it may take some time for all families to get set up. Because of this we will continue to email you school notifications through to **Thursday 14 April**. After this time all school communication will move to Hero.



Office Communication

We are currently operating our office with significantly reduced staffing, caused by some of our team being unable to work onsite. All of our office team are set up to work remotely, however, it is a great help to them if parent/caregiver communication could be by email wherever possible.

Kāhui Ako Staff only Day – Friday 25 March

A reminder that we will be holding a Staff only Day at KNS on Friday 25 March. Our staff will be working online with staff from all the nine member schools of the Kāhui Ako; Brooklyn School, Karori Normal School, Karori West Normal School, Kelburn Normal School, Northland School, Wadestown School, Wellington College, Wellington Girls' College and Makara Model School.

The day will be built around a keynote address from <u>Kathryn Berkett</u>, with a focus on building resilience.

COVID Updates

As outlined in previous newsletters, please email me if you wish to receive daily updates on the number of positive COVID cases at school. The reasons I decided not to send daily updates to all parents/caregivers were; not wanting to; 'bombard' people's inboxes and raise community anxiety levels.

Please find below information regarding the number of positive cases at KNS as of today:

- 25 children have returned to school after testing positive, completing the required self-isolation and having no COVID symptoms.
- In total we have 18 current positive cases throughout the school distributed as follows:
 - Year 0 0 current positive cases and 0 children returned to school
 - Year 1 1 current positive cases and 0 children returned to school
 - Year 2 1 current positive cases and 1 child returned to school
 - Year 3 2 current positive cases and 10 children returned to school
 - Year 4 2 current positive cases and 0 children returned to school
 - Year 5 4 current positive cases and 6 children returned to school
 - Year 6 2 current positive cases and 3 children returned to school
 - Year 7 4 current positive cases and 4 children returned to school
 - Year 8 2 current positive cases and 1 child returned to school
